- 1. As you are aware, the Insurance Act, 2017 (Act) (Section 85 of the Act refers) requires all persons intending to carry on the business of risk advisor, loss assessor and loss adjuster in Uganda to be licensed by the Insurance Regulatory Authority of Uganda (Authority).
- 2. In this connection, please apply through the online licensing platform available on our website (www.ira.go.ug) and submit all the requirements together with evidence of payment of the non-refundable application (license) fees of Ushs. 400,000/= per type of business by 31st August 2021. Failure to apply by that date and/or submission of incomplete application will attract a penalty.
- 3. We also take this opportunity to remind you of the following for the eventual issuance of the license:
 - (i) All Loss Assessors/Adjusters and Risk Advisors' licenses will be renewed by 1st December 2021 for a period of two (2) years. Please note that we shall, at an appropriate date in the future, inform you about the key documents you shall be required to submit to the Authority as evidence of continued compliance.
